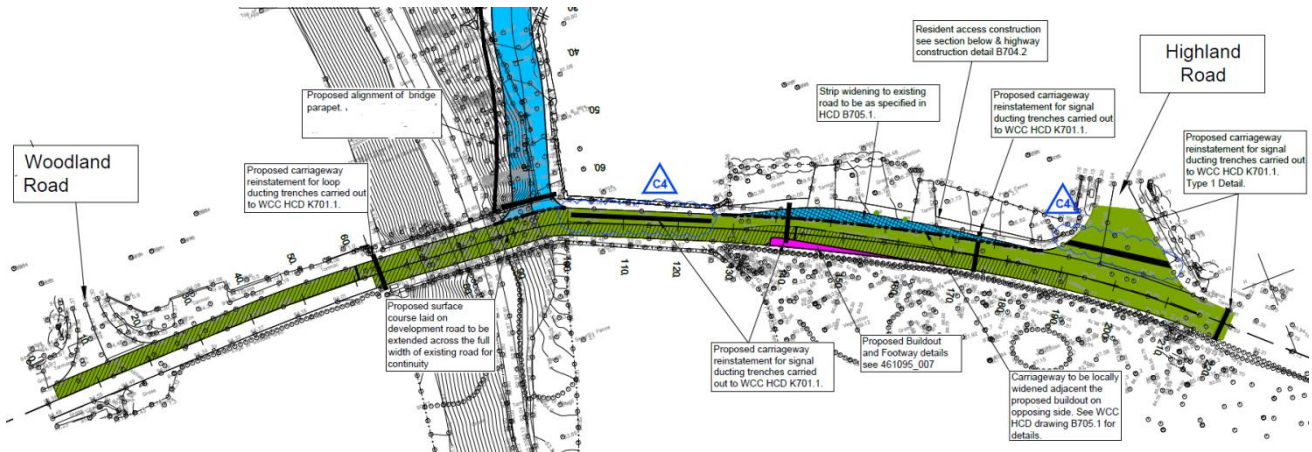
Temporary Road Closure of Common Lane Overbridges

Please note that Common Lane, between Highland Road and Woodland Road, will be closed during the following dates:

1 week from Monday 18th February to Sunday 24th February 2019 - 24hr Closure
1 week from Monday 25th February to Monday 4th March 2019 - 09:30 to 15:30

The closure is required for carriageway planing and resurfacing (shown in green below), lining works and traffic signals equipment installation. These works are part of Warwickshire County Council's new junction works for the proposed Bloor Homes housing development associated with planning permission number W/14/1340.

The vehicle diversion route will be available via Dale House Lane, Stoneleigh Road and the A429 Coventry Road. Please see the plan overleaf. Diversion signs for the route will be placed in advance of the closure.



During the closure, pedestrian routes will remain unaffected and vehicular access and egress to the individual properties within the extent of the closure will be maintained at all times.

Access to **Woodland Road** will only be available via the A429 Coventry Road. Access to **Highland Road** and the **Common Lane Industrial Estate** will only be available from Dale House Lane. Although works will be undertaken within the Highland Road junction, **full access will be maintained to Highland Road**. However, short delays are expected on occasions while vehicles are managed through the resurfacing works. To help minimise the disruption, the works on the Highland Road junction will be undertaken during off peak times.

We regret any inconvenience that may be caused during these essential works and assure you that every effort will be made to mitigate the disruption and to ensure that these works will be completed as quickly and as efficiently as possible.
