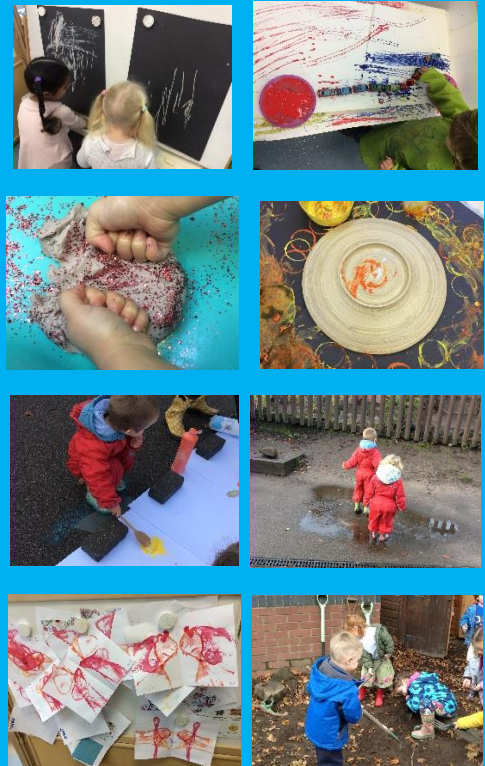


'Write Dance...'
to help us write!!!!



This week we found out all about scribbling!
Music and dance is used to guide children's imagination and language development, then pieces of music, with the corresponding movements, are structured into 'narrative' themes that are developed as stories.
Rhythm is closely linked to rhyme and children are encouraged to use their voices to describe the actions as they move and dance. Mark-making and 'movement drawings' ensure that the children progress from whole body dance moves to fine-motor movements with fluency and speed. This provides a crucial learning environment and stimulating programme to support and develop mature physical skills more quickly.
