# Spotlight on sounds:

As we continue to develop good strong reading foundations with our phonics for the Badgers, we have begun to target

oral segmenting and blending skills:
"But what are oral segmenting and blending skills,
and why are they important?" (I hear you cry...!)
It is segmenting a word into separate phonemes and
then immediately blending the sounds together to
say the word, as much as possible in real situations.

## It's time to get your h-a-t, hat!

(But... only use single syllable words for oral blending, otherwise it gets REALLY complicated!!)
Children are then in a great position when they start writing - because they can hear all the different sounds that make up a single word.

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
