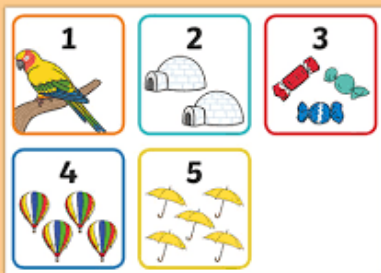


What are we doing next week?

Phonics: Aspect 7 - Oral blending

In this aspect, the main aim is to develop oral blending and segmenting skills. To practise oral blending, you could say some sounds, such as /c/-/u/-/p/ and see whether your child can pick out a cup from a group of objects.

Maths: Cardinality and Counting: understanding that the cardinal value of a number refers to the quantity, or 'howmanyness' of things it represents

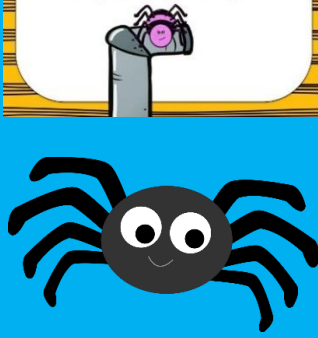


Nursery Rhyme of the week...
