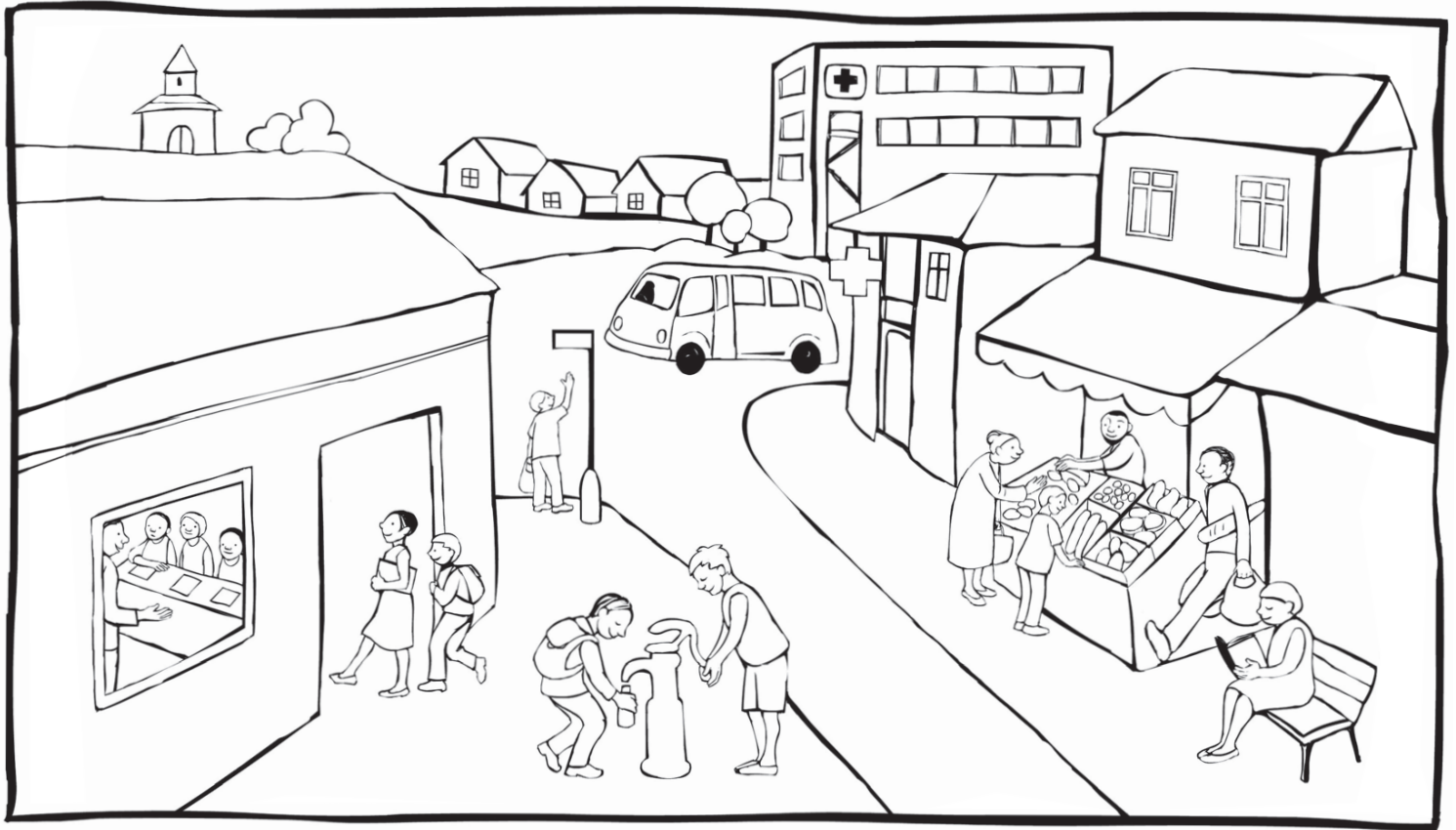


# Third Sunday of Lent (Year A)
