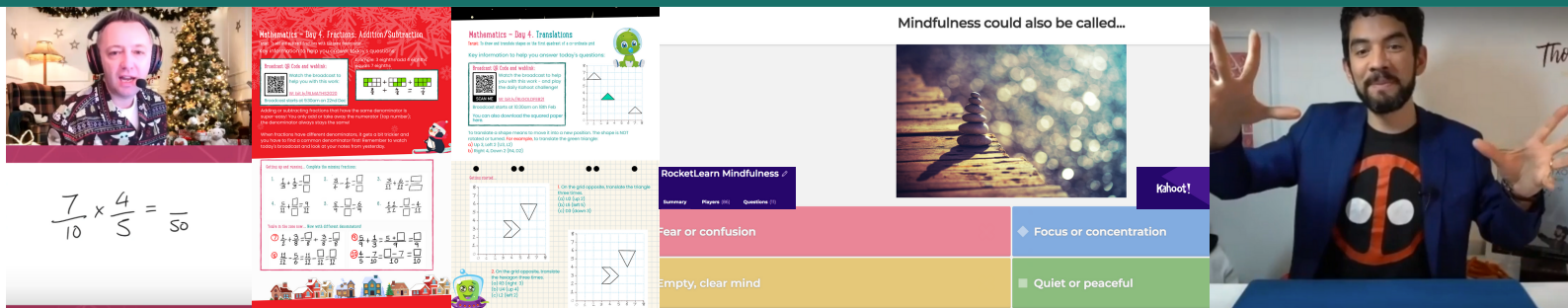

If you are looking for a way to keep your child purposefully occupied over the holidays we are here to help. All our Maths and English is mapped to the UK curriculum, and it is envisaged all tasks will take around an hour a day. We have three different levels of Maths, (Bronze for yrs 3&4, Silver 5&6, Gold 7&8) and a fantastic Creative writing competition with prizes for different ages. In our "afternoon antics" sessions we look at learning new skills and the importance of learning. Finally, we have ten PE and Well-being sessions which are great fun for all the family.

# Frequently asked questions



What do I need to do so my child can take part in the camps?

What equipment do we need?

Any internet enabled device. We advise printing the work books if possible, but if not the work can be completed with a pen and paper. All of our quizzes are online.

Is there a timetable?

Yes - however this is completely optional, they are there for those families who like structure. You can access all the activities as and when you want throughout the holidays.

My child is finding it difficult what can I do?

We have three levels Bronze, Silver and Gold, if your child is doing Silver or Gold we suggest they try a lower level. If they are on Bronze and are struggling you can email us and one of our team of teachers will try and give further explanation. The videos can be paused and re-watched so hopefully this will also help.

Plus, we have parental booklets which have all the answers together with tips on how to further help your child.

How does my child win a prize or certificate?

All children who complete the quiz on the last day will be awarded a certificate. Prizes will be awarded to submitted work for the "Afternoon Antics". We also have a national Creative Writing competition for our English weeks - do encourage your children to participate - they can win amazon vouchers.

What topics do you cover?

We cover Maths and English for years 3-8. Our afternoon sessions are "academic enrichment" and are designed to inspire and engage children, so they cover a wide range of topics. Our wellbeing and PE challenges are also great fun for the whole family. We know that during school holidays children need a rest, therefore our activities have been designed to be fun, engaging and light learning.

Will the school know if my child does or doesn't participate?

We send the results from the quizzes and any prize results to your school, so they can share in your success if you have been awarded a prize or certificate. The aim of the programme is for your child to enjoy learning, try new things and keep them happy and healthy over the holiday.
