Costumes for the Summer production

Your child will be performing in the Summer Production and will require a costume (or two). We would be very grateful if you would provide costumes as shown below and bring these items in to school by Wednesday 20 June in a named carrier bag and ask your child to hand it to their class teacher.

The Wizard of Oz - Year 6 characters

- **Dorothy** – Blue and white checked dress with a puffy sleeved top underneath. Start with school shoes and then switch to red sparkly shoes. A basket and blue ribbon for hair. See internet for ideas
- **Scarecrow** – brown patchy trousers, baggy blue or dark green long sleeve top. String or robe belt around waist and wrists. Hay sticking out all over costume and a scarecrow hat of any colour. See internet for ideas.
- **Tinman** – Silver trousers and long sleeved top. Silver-funnel hat. Fake silver axe, an oil can and a large heart necklace. See internet for ideas.
- **Lion** – Lion onesie or all brown top and trousers with a long curly brown wig. See internet for ideas.
- **Wizard of Oz** - Black trousers and shoes. Shirt with a patterned suit waist coat, green suit jacket. Black top hat. See internet for ideas.
- **Oz Assistant** – Green dress with green tights (can be stripey).
- **Glinda** - Pink fairy dress with puffy sleeves, long wand with a star at the top and a crown. Party shoes. See internet for ideas.
- **Wicked Witch** – Long black witch dress and pointy witch hat. See internet for ideas.
- **Aunty Em** – Flower patterned dress with a white apron. See internet for ideas.
- **Uncle Henry** – Checked shirt and plain brown trousers, brown waistcoat and flat cap. See internet for ideas.
- **Zeke** - Checked shirt and plain brown trousers and a flat cap. See internet for ideas.
- **Doorman** – Green top and bottoms, green cape and a fluffy green tall hat.
- **Narrators** – Black school shoes and black trousers and a green t-shirt.

The Little Mermaid year 6 characters

- **Ariel** – 2 costumes required
- Purple top with long green skirt with a belt that has two long pieces of green light fabric (organza/chiffon) which can attach to your fingers. Please check my earlier email. Shorts to be worn under the skirt. Sandals and a long red wig.
- Blue dress or skirt and top with a black corset style on top. Black shoes. See internet for ideas.
- **Mermaids** – Please make your own. Each mermaid to be a different colour if you could discuss with your friends but no green. A plain bright coloured strappy top or a seashell patterned top. Long flowing skirt to match your top and sandals. Belt that has two long pieces of same light coloured fabric (organza/chiffon) which can attach to your fingers. Please check my earlier email.

- **Prince Eric** – Black boots with blue baggy trousers tucked in. Loose fitting white shirt with no buttons and open collar and a red sash.
- **Grimsby** – Suit with a shirt and a cravat. Large yellow rain coat with wellingtons. See internet for details.
- **Ursula** – Black and purple multi layered dress/ top and skirt. (perhaps use tutus/underskirts) See internet for ideas.
- **Jetsam and Flotsam** – Green tights and top with a black netting top and cut up black leggings over the tights.
- **King Triton** – Turquoise trousers with a fin and a skin coloured top. White beard and a Trident and a gold crown. See internet for ideas.
- **Sebastian** – Red crab costume. Please speak to other Sebastians so that you match.
- **Flounder** – Blue and yellow shorts and top or a blue and yellow fish costume.
- **Scuttle** – White seagull outfit. See internet for ideas.
- **Chef** – Chef trousers and jacket with a chef's hat to be secured with hair grips. School shoes.
- **Narrators** – Black trousers and school shoes and a blue t-shirt.

My Fair Lady year 6 characters

- **Eliza 1** – Long green jacket, long, dark, full skirt (may need underskirt) a half body apron, a blouse with a thin red wool scarf to be criss-crossed and held with a pin. School shoes. See internet for ideas.
- **Eliza 2** – Full red skirt, floor length (may need an underskirt), Edwardian puffed sleeve frill blouse (light colour but not white) and school shoes. See internet for ideas.
- **Eliza 3** - Two costumes required. Edwardian puffed sleeve frill blouse (light colour, not white), green pinafore dress with a black waist belt. Cream, black and pink floor length dress, pleated at the bottom with long sleeves. A large hat to go with it and school shoes. See internet for ideas.
- **Eliza 4** – Cream, floor length night dress with long sleeves. Slippers.
- **Higgins** – Brown trousers and jacket with a school shirt and tie. School shoes. A button up cardigan and a 3-piece suit and top hat for Ascot scene. Perhaps a brown waistcoat to go with original outfit. See internet for ideas.
- **Pickering** – three-piece suit – black with a school shirt and a cravat. Cane and a war medal. Top hat and a peaked cap
- **Mrs Pearce** – Full floor length dark skirt with a matching jacket. An Edwardian frill long sleeved blouse underneath. School shoes and a half body apron.
- **Doolittle** – School shoes, black trousers, a loose shirt and a brown waistcoat.
- **Narrators** – black three-piece suit with a grey shirt and a cravat. Brown and patchy poor man's waistcoat. Top hat and a peaked cap

We ask that you Google your character and set musical for inspiration for costumes. If you are at all unsure, please do not hesitate to contact me and I will check any pictures you send or show me. If you are struggling to acquire an appropriate costume. Please do get in touch and me and I will see if the school has anything suitable to be borrowed.
