Costumes for the Summer production

Your child will be performing in the Summer Production and will require a costume. We would be very grateful if you would provide a costume as shown below. Please bring these items in to school by Wednesday 20 June in a named carrier bag and ask your child to hand it to their class teacher.

The Wizard of Oz – Reception

- Boys - brightly coloured cut trousers or shorts (or tucked into socks), plain brightly coloured tops (no slogans or logos on) or checked shirt;
- Girls - full skirts or dress with apron or tutus; pattern or plain
- Stripy socks or tights in a bright colour;
- Suitable accessories, bow ties, leg warmers and braces.

The Wizard of Oz – Year 4

- Boys - green cut trousers or shorts (or tucked into socks), plain green coloured tops (no slogans or logos on) or checked shirt;
- Girls – green full skirts or dress with apron or tutus;
- Stripy socks black, white, green or green tights;
- Suitable accessories, bow ties, leg warmers, braces, waist coats;
- Green party hat or novelty headband.

The Little Mermaid –Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3

Children **must be able to dance** and have a good range of movement in their costumes! They need summer shoes but no flip flops or Crocs. Shoes must fit the foot securely. Please be creative with the costumes and feel free to check with me as I would not want to ask you to change it due to lack of ability to move suitably for the dance.

Please choose a sea creature of your choice:

- Sea Creatures – blue top and bottoms with felt sea creatures stuck on. No red crabs or blue and yellow striped fish, no mermaid costumes and no sharks.
- Turtle - green/yellow top and bottoms;
- Fish - scales in any colour (sequins work well)
- Octopus – orange;
- Sea horse – any colour;
- Star fish – any colour;



My Fair Lady – Year 5

All children to wear school shoes

- Boys – three-piece suit in grey or black with a school shirt and a cravat;
- Poor man brown and patchy waistcoat;
- Top hat – and a peaked cap;

- Girls – long floor length, dark coloured skirt with an Edwardian, light coloured (not white) long sleeve-frill blouse;
- Maids apron - full body apron and a poor person shawl;
- Large black, corset belt;
- Mop cap;
- Large wedding hat to match your outfit (nothing too expensive).

We ask that you Google your character and set musical for inspiration for costumes.
