## **Costumes for the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Decade Dance**

As part of our calendared celebrations to commemorate the last 75 years, each year has been given a decade to devise a song and dance from.

Junior 2 have been allocated the 1950s and we have opted to go for a 50s rock and roll theme. Each child will dress up and perform the routine on 19 March and will therefore need a costume.

We would be very grateful if you would provide a costume as shown below. Please bring these items into school by Wednesday 11 March in a named carrier bag and ask your child to hand it to their class teacher.

### **50s Rock and Roll Costume**

#### **Boys costume:**

- Plain white t-shirt
- Plain black trousers (skinny fit if possible) for the t-shirt to be tucked in.
- White ankle socks.
- White/light-coloured converse style trainers.

#### **Girls costume:**

- Plain white t-shirt
- Flared 50s style skirt in any colour
- Necktie (or a piece of fabric that can be used as a necktie) in the same colour as the skirt.
- White/light-coloured converse style trainers.
- White ankle socks.
- Hair ties (scrunchies) in the same colour again so that hair can be put up into a high ponytail





We ask that you **google your decade** for inspiration for costumes. Charity shops and/or past pupils are also a good starting point in terms of alternative resources. If you are at all unsure, please do not hesitate to contact us and we can check any picture you have.

Please let us know if your child has an allergy to face paint or hair gel.
