Costumes for the 75th Anniversary Decade dance

Junior 6 have been allocated the 1970s and we have opted to go for a 70s disco theme. Each child will dress up and perform the routine on 19 March and will therefore need a costume.

We would be very grateful if you would provide a costume as shown below. Please bring these items into school by Wednesday 11 March in a named carrier bag and ask your child to hand it to their class teacher.

70s Disco

- 70s Stud: Loose, button-down shirts paired with corduroy flare pants, rhinestone belt, cowboy boots
- **Disco Fever:** Flashy metallic or paisley open neck "Disco" shirt, white flare jeans, white platform shoes, gold chain necklace
- Studio 54: A snug open top shirt, bell bottom jeans, wide leather belt, platform shoes
- Disco Doll: Polyester or metallic jumpsuit, gold sandals, big dangly earrings
- Casual Dancer: Knit top, flare pants or jeans, platform shoes, plastic jewellery
- **Disco Ball:** Sequin top, flare jeans, mid-high sandal heels, rhinestone jewellery

Please do not buy anything that could be mistaken for 80s disco or 60s flower power.
