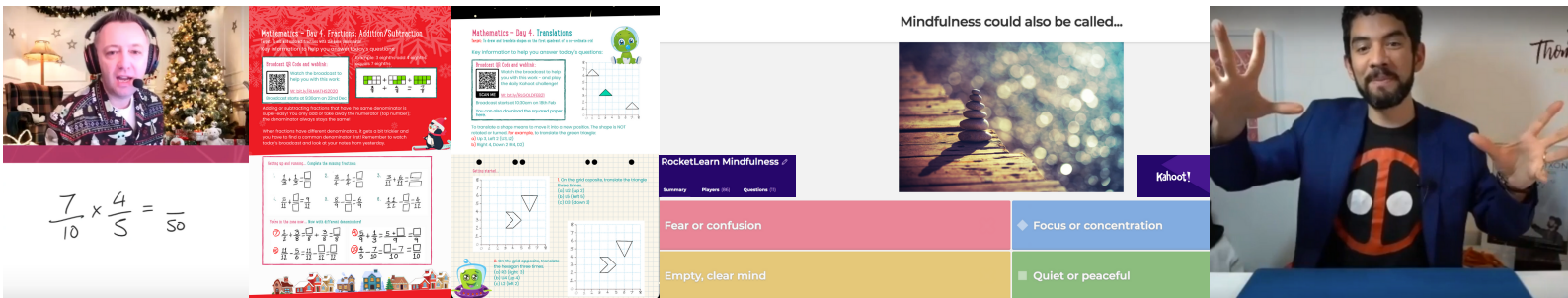


Holiday Learning Camps

Frequently asked questions

What do I need to do so my child can take part in the camps?

What equipment do we need?

Any wifi enabled device. We advise printing the books off if possible – but if not the work can be completed with a pen and paper – and the quizzes are all online.

Do we have to follow the timetable?

No! We know how busy family life is, we have set times for our broadcasts to "launch" as some families like that structure. You are welcome to do the activities as and when you please.

What if we are away or busy one day?

No problem! All our camps stay available so you can catch up at your leisure.

My child is finding it difficult what can I do?

We have three levels Bronze, Silver and Gold. If your child is doing Silver or Gold we suggest they try a lower level. If they are on Bronze and are struggling you can email us and one of our team of teachers will try and give further explanation. The videos can be paused and re-watched so hopefully this too will help.

Plus we have parental booklets which have all the answers together with tips on how to further help your child.

How does my child win a prize or certificate?

All children who complete the quiz on the last day will be awarded a certificate and prizes will be awarded to submitted work for the "afternoon antics".

What topics do you cover?

We cover Maths and English for years 3–8. Our afternoon sessions are "academic enrichment" and are designed to inspire and engage children so cover a wide range of topics. We know that this is the school holiday and children need a rest. Our activities have been designed to be fun and engaging, and light learning.

Will the school know if my child does or doesn't participate?

We send the results from the quizzes to all our schools. This is useful for them as it can help them tailor their learning to your child should they notice any gaps. Our Maths and English sessions are about consolidating and revisiting topics- we are not teaching new concepts.

We know that holidays are there for a reason, our activities are designed to be fun and enriching, complimenting the traditional holiday activities of family time, relaxation and reoperation.
