Costumes for the Summer Production

Your child will be performing in the Summer Production, or as part of the prelude, and will require a costume. We would be very grateful if you would provide a costume as described below. Please bring these items in to school by **Wednesday 8 June**, in a named carrier bag and ask your child to hand it to their class teacher.

All children are to wear school shoes.

Aladdin - Reception, Junior 1, Junior 3 and Junior 5

Boys - Hareem trousers and a brightly coloured plain t-shirt (no print or logo on it). Girls - Hareem trousers, or appropriate skirt, and a brightly coloured plain t-shirt (no print or logo on it).

J5 Boys - If you would like to accessorise: a brightly coloured Aladdin style waistcoat.

J5 Girls - Brightly coloured chiffon material/scarf to secure around waist.

If you search for Arabian child costumes on Google or Amazon, there will be pictures to inspire you. Please **do not** purchase Aladdin or Princes Jasmine costumes as these need to be worn by Junior 6 principal characters.

The Lion King - Junior 2 and Junior 4

Please select one of the following animals and provide a top and trousers in an appropriate colour/animal print - Zebra, Elephant, Lion, Antelope, Giraffe or Leopard.

Please <u>do not</u> add manes or headpieces to your costumes which can restrict visibility of the face on stage. Animal ears on a headband are permitted. Please <u>do not</u> wear a onesie as it can get extremely warm under the stage lighting.

We ask that you google your character, or musical for inspiration. If you are at all unsure, please do not hesitate to contact me at rodkefalas@crackleyhall.co.uk and I will check any pictures you send or show me. If you are struggling to acquire an appropriate costume, please do get in touch and I will see if the school has anything suitable. Could you also please let me know if your child has an allergy to face paint.
