

Costumes for the Summer Production – Junior 6

Your child will be performing in the Summer Production and will require at least one costume. We would be very grateful if you would provide costumes as shown below. Please bring these items into school by **Monday 19 May** in a named carrier bag and ask your child to hand it to their class teacher.

Treachery at Traitors Quay

The play is set in the 1940s - please Google the era to find historically appropriate costumes.

All children should wear school shoes, unless otherwise stated.

For some items, it may be better to bulk buy / one person buy a number of the item to reduce delivery costs.

Miss Albright - 1940s style midi tea-dress / skirt with a blouse and a blazer

Mrs Dawson and Auntie Peg – 1940s style midi tea-dress / skirt with a blouse and a cardigan with a cloche hat

Billy and Duggie – knee high dark socks, dark shorts with a shirt and tank top

Lizzie, Josie and Rosie – 1940s style dress, cardigan and knee length socks,

Evacuees – Girls - 1940s style dress, cardigan and knee length socks **Evacuees –** Boys - knee high dark socks, dark shorts with a shirt and tank top

Mums - 1940s style midi tea-dress / skirt with a blouse and a cardigan with apron and/or head scarf

Eggin-Drake - tweed jacket and smart dark trousers, shirt and tie

Etta – 1940s style smart dress, costumes jewellery and a handbag

Hennie and Duccie - riding leggings and boots / wellingtons, riding jacket, riding hat

Mr Mulch – navy blue jacket and trousers / jumpsuit, white school shirt or t-shirt underneath, whistle on string/ribbon, blue hat with chin strap with a white 'W' on the front, white armband with ARP written on.

HM Grogg – navy jumper, trousers, neckerchief and peaked cap and a telescope.

Wheeler and Dealer – khaki / brown / green top or jacket with lots of pockets, similar coloured trousers, a forage style cap – all old army uniform style, yellow armband with HOMEGUARD written on, a small broom

Private Jolly and Private Jape – khaki / brown / green top or jacket with lots of pockets, similar coloured trousers, a forage style cap – all old army uniform style, yellow armband with HOMEGUARD written on, a small broom

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Kitchener – khaki / brown / green top or jacket with lots of pockets, similar coloured trousers, a forage style cap – all old army uniform style, yellow armband with HOMEGUARD written on. (Cane to be provided by school.)

Parker – tweed jacket and brown trousers with a cream shirt, flat cap, boots. (Wooden rifle to be provided by school.)

Air-Raid Wardens – navy blue jacket and trousers / jumpsuit, a white school shirt or t-shirt underneath, whistle on string / ribbon, blue hat with chin strap with a white 'W' on the front, white armband with ARP written on.

Land Girls - blouse, dungarees, headscarf

Home Guard – khaki / brown / green top or jacket with lots of pockets, similar coloured trousers, a forage style cap – all old army uniform style, yellow armband with HOMEGUARD written on. (Cane to be provided by school.)

Mrs Lovham – 1940s style dress/skirt and blouse with a flowery wrap-around overall

Churchill - dark suit with a white shirt and bow tie, a Churchill hat

We suggest that you **Google your character** for further inspiration for costumes. On the final page are some pictures for ideas. If you are at all unsure, please do not hesitate to contact Mrs Paphitis who will check any pictures you send or show her. If you are struggling to acquire an appropriate costume, please do get in touch with Mrs Paphitis and she will see if the school has anything suitable to be borrowed.
