



### **Costumes for the Summer Production - Reception to Junior 5**

Your child will be performing in the Summer Production and will require a costume. We would be very grateful if you would provide a costume as shown below. Please bring these items into school by **Monday 19 May** in a named carrier bag and ask your child to hand it to the class teacher.

**The play is set in the 1940s - please Google the era to find historically appropriate costumes for J3, J4 and J5s.**

**All children should wear school shoes, unless otherwise stated.**

**For some items, it may be better to bulk buy / one person buy a number of the item to reduce delivery costs.**

### **Reception, Junior 1 and Junior 2 - Summer Holiday**

Summer clothes – shirts/t-shirts, shorts, trainers or summer shoes which are secured at the back. No flip flops as these are not safe to dance in.



### **Junior 3 – Evacuees**

Girls - 1940s style dress, cardigan and knee length socks

Boys - knee high dark socks, dark shorts with a shirt and tank top



#### Junior 4 – Air-Raid Wardens

Navy blue jacket and trousers/skirt or jumpsuit, white school shirt or t-shirt underneath, whistle on string/ribbon, blue hat with chin strap with a white 'W' on the front, white armband with ARP written on.



#### Junior 5 – Land Girls / Home Guard

Land Girls: blouse, dungarees, headscarf or bow

Homeguard: khaki/brown/green top or jacket with lots of pockets, similar coloured trousers, a forage style cap – all old army uniform style, yellow armband with HOMEGUARD written on.
