Phonics: Aspect 6 - Voice sounds

The aim is to distinguish between different vocal sounds and to begin oral blending and segmenting. Children can hear and begin to say the sounds in words - /c/-/u/-/p/ cup.

Maths: Measures: comparing different aspects such as length, weight and volume, as a preliminary to using units to compare later.

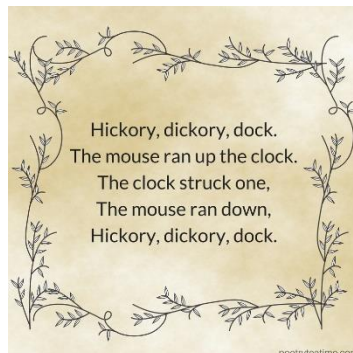
