# AUTUMN HOUSE 'ART' COMPETITION 2024



This half term's House Art Competition is a little different so read <u>very</u>, <u>very</u> carefully.

The competition has been split into two different areas.

## Reception and Key Stage 1

Your job is to create a wonderful superhero. Could be male or female, real or imaginary. Could be a family member or friend......or, you could really use your imagination (which is what we like here at Crackley Hall and you could make up someone really special).

You will design a costume for your superhero and don't forget to add some text and tell us what your character's super-powers are! Work can be in pencil pen, coloured pencil or felt tip.

Remember your work should be bright and bold - and no larger than A3.

### Key Stage 2

For this competition, Ms Holmes would like you to design your own comic strip of no more than 6 frames just like the template below.

Comic strips are used to tell a story. They have three main parts of a story: setting, characters, and plot. Comic strips use words and pictures equally. Comic strips use a series of frames to show story movement.

You can choose some characters and you will need to think about text and speech bubbles. Make your images bold and exciting (could be black and white or you may wish to add vibrant colour (felt tips usually work best for this).

House points: 5 for entering, 10 for third place, 20 for second place and 25 for first place.

\*The winner of the KS2 competition will also design get to design a new comic strip using the superhero from the winner of the Reception/KS1 entries.
