Costumes for the Summer production

Your child will be performing in the Summer Production and will require at least one costume. We would be very grateful if you would provide costumes as shown below. Please bring these items in to school by Monday 12 June in a named carrier bag and ask your child to hand it to their class teacher.

Please avoid hats / headpieces unless specified as these can cause issues with movement and microphones.

All children should wear school shoes unless otherwise stated.

Peter Pan - Traditional green outfit (tunic and leggings) with pockets or pouch for fairy dust, and a hat that can be secured to your head. A small sword/cutlass secured in a belt.

Paddy Pan - Traditional Peter Pan (tunic and leggings) outfit but in brown, and a hat that can be secured to your head. A small sword/cutlass secured in a belt.

Shadow – Peter Pan outfit (tunic and leggings) but in black, and a hat that can be secured to your head.

Wendy – Long old-fashioned nightgown (not white). Foliage headpiece that can be secured to your head.

Mr Darling – Dark coloured suit, shirt and tie.

Mrs Darling – Edwardian style dress.

John – Old-fashioned pyjamas, a top hat and a blazer type jacket.

Michael – Old-fashioned pyjamas and a blazer type jacket.

Hook – Traditional (mainly black and red) Captain Hook outfit with hat, and large hook.

Look – Traditional Hook outfit but mainly blue and black



Mermaid Queen - Lots of sparkle and shine! A large tiara, bright coloured top or a seashell patterned top and mermaid leggings, as shown, or similarly shiny or sequined leggings plus a plastic hairbrush or handheld mirror. Closed toe summer shoes / ballet pumps that are fastened around the back (this is for safety).

Nana – Dog coloured leggings and top, doggy ears and tail. Old-fashioned nanny-type hat and apron.

Mr Smee– Traditional pirate outfit. A small sword/cutlass secured in a belt.

Tinkerbell – Traditional green fairy outfit with wings. If possible, she should have a light around her neck, which can be switched on and off. Closed toe summer shoes / ballet pumps that are fastened around the back (this is for safety).

Silvermist – Traditional silver fairy outfit with wings. Closed toe summer shoes / ballet pumps that are fastened around the back (this is for safety).

Tiger Lily – Native American dress with a secured head piece.

Narrator – Black trousers, green t-shirt and a sparkly bow tie.

Pirate scene – As above but with visible pirate accessory (bandana/patch/hat etc)

Mermaid Scene – As above but with sea creature accessory (fish headband/hat)

Nursery scene – As above but with top hat.

Warrior scene – As above but with a Native American headpiece

Lost Boys – T-shirt and shorts in forest colours with some foliage added, optional simple jacket. A small sword/cutlass secured in a belt.

Pirate – Traditional pirate outfit with small sword/cutlass secured in a belt.

Mermaid– Lots of sparkle and shine! A bright coloured top or a seashell patterned top and mermaid leggings as shown or similarly shiny or sequined leggings. Plastic hairbrush or handheld mirror. We ask that you avoid tight mermaid skirt costumes as these restrict dance movements. Closed toe summer shoes / ballet pumps that are fastened around the back (this is for safety).

Liza – Long black skirt, white blouse and an apron.

Ships Cook – Black trousers, stripy top, an apron and chef's hat with skull and crossbones on. A small sword/cutlass secured in a belt.

Wild Warrior – Native American outfit with secure headpiece.

Warrior Queen – Native American outfit with headpiece.

Chief – Native American outfit with equivalent elaborate feathered headpiece.

Croc – Green top with trousers, a crocodile head piece and crocodile tail, or a crocodile onesie.
