High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

Construction Update.

In July we shared information about the forthcoming closure of the A429 Kenilworth Road from Monday 2 September to Sunday 29 September. As we have continued to develop our programme we have identified the need to undertake further inspections and surveys of drainage and utilities, as well as verge maintenance, ahead of the planned closure. To do this safely manned stop-go boards will be used.

When will these works be taking place?

Phase one: Monday 16 September – Friday 27 September

Stop-go boards will be operated as required during off peak hours between 9.30am to 3.30pm Monday to Friday only.

We will be undertaking further surveys and verge maintenance.

Phase two: Monday 30 September – Friday 25 October

A 24/7 full road closure of A429 Kenilworth Road will be in place for four weeks. A fully signposted diversion will be in place.

We will be undertaking the relocation of utilities to the new road alignment and completing earthworks to build the embankments.

Access for pedestrians and cyclists will be maintained.

Phase three: Early 2025

We will install another full road closure to complete the permanent road realignment. Details will be shared early next year.

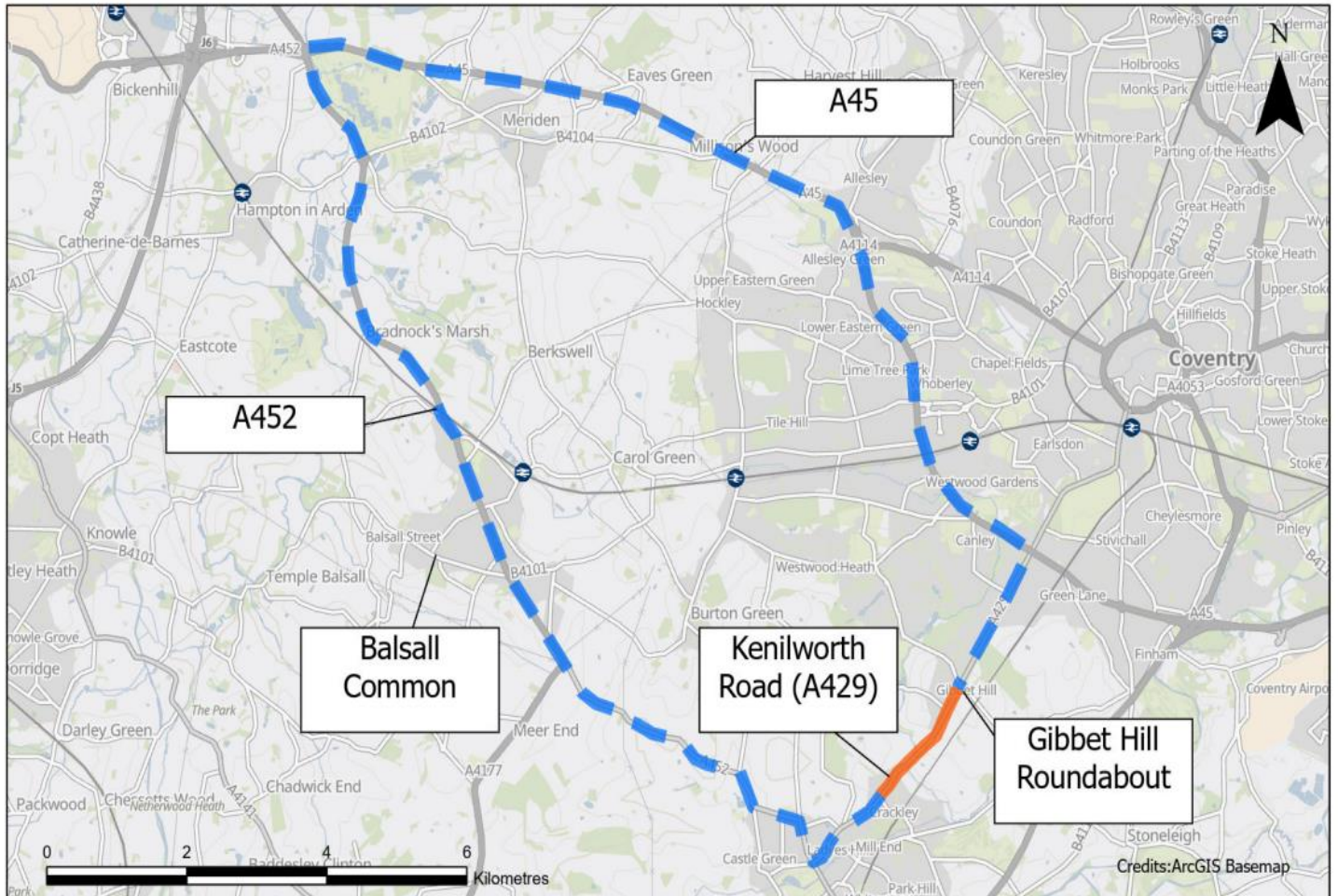

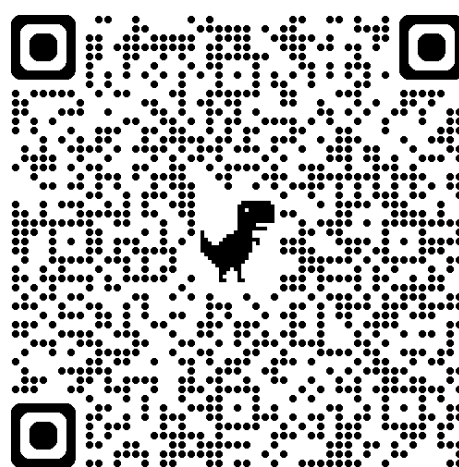
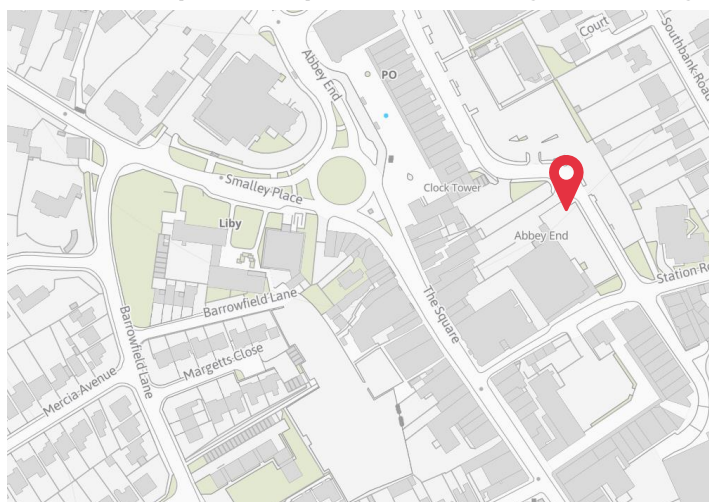
