**Junior 6 - First Aid Training – Trip No 1379**

We are excited to announce that we have arranged for our Junior 6 pupils to receive some First Aid training. They are at that stage where they are gaining independence, so it's really beneficial for them to have these skills under their belt before heading off to secondary school. We will run these sessions over two days: **Monday 23 April** and **Tuesday 24 April**. There will be two morning sessions of 12 children each on both days. This certificate in First Aid will cost a mere £6 – a small price to pay for potentially saving a life!

The sessions are approximately an hour in length. They are fun and interactive sessions, designed to encourage children to think about the actions they would take in an emergency situation if no adults were present. The session will cover: CPR, recovery position, burns, cuts, choking, head injuries and fractures. A certificate of attendance is also given to each child at the end of the class. Our provider is a qualified paediatric first aid trainer.

I am sure you will agree that this is a super opportunity for the children and that you give permission for your child to partake.
