Junior 4 LAMDA Examinations in Verse & Prose

All of the children from Junior 4 will be studying the London Academy of Music and Dramatic Arts (LAMDA) syllabus for Entry Level Speaking of Verse and Prose in their school drama lessons. This syllabus covers many National Curriculum requirements for English as well as offering the children the opportunity to take an accredited examination.

During this term the children will be choosing and learning a piece of poetry of their choice at school. Please encourage your child to keep their copies at home to learn from memory. I would like them to have learnt their poem **securely from memory as soon as possible** but by Friday 1 December at the very latest. The children then have the Christmas break to work on clear diction, expressive communication and a variety of volume levels before they are given their second poem to learn after the Christmas break.

Every week I will give each child a target to work towards to help them prepare their piece to examination standard. Please ask them what their target is for the week and support them to achieve it.

We will be visited by external examiners from LAMDA on 27-28 February and 1-2 March 2018.

Please could you and your child discuss this opportunity to receive accreditation for their learning in drama. **If they do not wish to take the examination they will still be following the same LAMDA curriculum in drama lessons and be expected to practise and rehearse their poem exactly the same as the children who are taking the exam.** The examination standard is high but I would expect everyone in our current Junior 5 to achieve it if they are willing to work hard and practise their pieces regularly. Considerable support from home will be required! The cost of the examination is £35.00. Should your child wish to take the exam, this amount will be added to your next school invoice; **please do not send payment in to school.** Please would you complete the attached reply slip indicating your decision and return it to the school office by **Friday 24 November.**

LAMDA have strict regulations with regards to the completion of entry forms and late entries will not be accepted by them; please make a note of the closing date. I cannot add additional entries once the deadline has passed.
