Enabling children to quickly achieve independence.



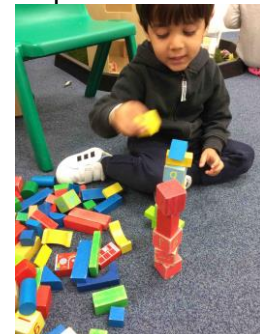
