Information for Acts

- ★ New format for 2019 ... GOLDEN TICKET: two entries from each year group will be picked out of a hat to perform at this year's Crackley's Got Talent being held as part of Family Fun Day.
- ★ Submit your Crackley's Got Talent entry to your class teacher by 1st May, with the golden ticket winners announced in Celebration Assembly on Friday 3rd May.
- ★ When choosing your Act, ask these questions: Is it unique? Is it entertaining? Will I enjoy performing it? Will the audience enjoy watching and listening to it? Think about grouping together with friends from your year group to form a duet, trio or larger group Act.
- ★ Example Acts: juggling, comedy skit, dance routine, karate display, poetry recital, singing, gymnastics, joke telling, musical recital anything entertaining!
- ★ Each Act to last <u>no longer</u> than 3 minutes.
- ★ There are no auditions. A couple of rehearsal slots will be organised during the week leading up to the Show during a school day – date and times will be confirmed via the parents' email address given on the Entry Form.
- ★ Microphones, music stands, one keyboard, mats and chairs will be available please let us know via the Entry Form if your Act has any further requirements that you need the organisers to provide for you. Mr Vaughan will be our expert Sound & Instrument Technician for the afternoon.
- ★ The Show is being incorporated within the Family Fun Day being held in The Gables and, weather permitting, outdoors within the school grounds. There will be a classroom that can be used to change into your Show costume and leave equipment, if required. An informal stage area will be created outdoors (indoors if poor weather). We plan to have 2 Show-time slots during the afternoon starting at 3.00pm and 4.00pm with the younger performers being slotted into the earlier time slot.
- ★ Practise, practise, practise perhaps use time during the Easter holidays to practise your Act!

Unlike TV's Britain's Got Talent, there are no judges, no buzzers, no winners – it's all about taking part, having fun and celebrating the rich talents of our school family.

A certificate will be presented to all performers.
