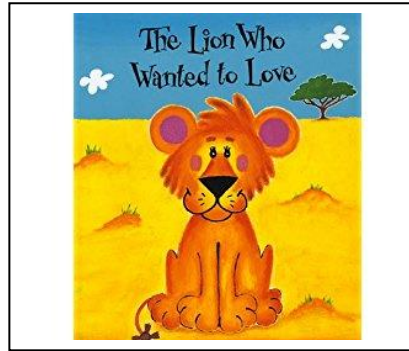


15th- 19th May, 2017.
